Graduation Requirements

LPS learners graduate under the Foundation High School Program with Endorsement. Learners must earn at least 26 credits to graduate with an endorsement under this plan. Below is an example of the credits needed to earn the multidisciplinary endorsement:

English – 4 credits	Mathematics – 4 credits	
Social Studies – 4 credits	Science – 4 credits	
Physical Education – 1 credit	Electives – 5+ credits	
Fine Arts – 1 credit	Speech - Demonstrated Proficiency	
Language other than English – 2 credits		

*Other endorsements available to our learners are STEM, Business & Industry, Public Service, and Arts & Humanities. To earn one of these endorsements, the learner's electives must follow a coherent sequence of classes within the selected discipline.

In addition to the criteria above, our current graduates complete:

- At least 40 hours of community service The class of 2024 will be required to complete:
- At least 40 hours of community service
- 40 hours of job shadowing and mentoring with a business partner within their 4 years of high school
- A sophomore and senior defense
